Brickner Family Memorial Scholarship

The Brickner Family Scholarship in Memory of the Fine Clinton Citizens and Loving Parents John and Lorraine Brickner Were, for their Children, Mary '50, and Robert '52 is a one-year scholarship award that each pay \$500 or more of tuition per semester to Southwestern Oklahoma State University. Mr. Brickner reserves the right to increase or extend this scholarship to deserving students.

This scholarship is awarded to a Clinton High School senior, preferably a minority student, for whom this grant will make a substantial difference as to whether attending college is a possibility. The Brickner Memorial scholarship recipients will be selected by Mr. Brickner with recommendations by the Clinton Public School Foundation Scholarship Committee, following review of the applications and personal interviews.

The Brickner Memorial Scholarship recipient will be responsible for providing the Clinton Public School Foundation with proof of full-time enrollment before the funds will be disbursed. The recipient will also provide proof of a 2.5 GPA for the first semester before the second semester's funds are disbursed. The Clinton Public School Foundation will pay Southwestern Oklahoma State University directly.

Application Deadline: Submitted to CHS counselor by February 21, 2020.

The application must include the following:

1. The attached Scholarship Application Form
2. A current resumé
3. Three letters of recommendation -- teachers, employers, community leaders.
