Clinton High School
Concurrent College Enrollment Scholarship

CPSF offers seven scholarships to CHS Juniors and Seniors taking concurrent college enrollment at an accredited Oklahoma college or university. Six scholarships will be given to Seniors. One scholarship will be awarded to a Junior. The amount of the Junior scholarship will be determined by the number of concurrent credit hours in which the student is enrolled. These scholarships are available for the fall and spring semesters. Scholarships will be paid directly to the college or university, or may be given to the student as a reimbursement for books.

Scholarship amounts are:

- Up to \$1,500 per semester for Junior enrolled in 6 hours of college credit.
- Up to \$300 per semester for a Junior enrolled in 3 hours of college credit.
- Up to \$300 per semester award for a Senior enrolled in 3 hours or more.

Clinton High School Students who meet the following criteria may apply for a Concurrent Enrollment Scholarship through CPSF:

1. Student must be a Clinton High School 11th or 12th grade student for the semester in which the scholarship is to be used.
2. Student must have met CHS requirements for concurrent enrollment.
3. Student must fully complete the scholarship application before the semester deadline.

The application must include the following:

1. The attached Scholarship Application Form.
2. One letter of recommendation vouching for the student's high level of responsibility.
3. A high school transcript that includes any previous concurrent enrollment if

Applications for the fall semester must be turned in the Clinton High School Counselor by the end of school day on the first Friday of April.

Applications for the spring semester must be received by a Clinton High School Counselor by the end of school day on the first Friday of November.

NOTE: Applicant's names must appear on every sheet included with application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
