K.B. Cornell, Jr. & Elise Cornell Scholarship

The K.B. Cornell, Jr. & Elise Cornell Scholarship is a one-year scholarship awarded to a Clinton High School senior attending the college or vocational program of his or her choice. The scholarship is worth \$1000, \$500 per semester, and emphasis will be placed on financial need. The Cornell Scholarship recipient will be selected by the Clinton Public School Foundation Scholarship Committee, following review of the applications and personal interviews.

The Cornell Scholarship recipient will be responsible for providing the Clinton Public School Foundation with proof of full-time enrollment before the funds will be disbursed. The recipient will also provide proof of a 2.5 GPA for the first semester before the second semester's funds will be disbursed.

Application Deadline: Submitted to CHS counselor by February 21, 2020.

The application must include the following:

1. The attached Scholarship Application Form
2. A current resumé, including three references with addresses and telephone numbers
3. A typed paragraph explaining any special circumstances that your family may have in regards to income
